The K6IS Group is for members of the North Hills Radio Club (NHRC), an Amateur (Ham) Radio Club, in the North area of Sacramento County, California. K6IS is the call sign assigned by the FCC for Amateur Radio stations controlled by the Club, including the FM repeater stations described in the Club web page <http://www.k6is.org>.

To apply to join this Group, always state your Ham call, if any.

Join the group.

You will be subscribed to the mailing list, and will have access to all the group's Web tools such as Message Archives, Polls, Files and Photos

Note: If you select this option you will be asked to sign in or register for a Yahoo! ID.

6) "Join the group" is strongly recommended. You will be directed to the Yahoo Sign In page. If you have a Yahoo ID, log in. If not, select Sign Up. If you don't see the following screen, go to 7) now.

You must first create a Yahoo! Profile

To use Yahoo! Groups, you must first create a public profile. This is a name which you will be known by within the group. It will be used to identify you when you use group features such as Messages, Chat, Photos, and Calendar, and it will be displayed in the Members area of your group. You can use your real name or a nickname.

- 7) You will be asked why you wish to join the K6IS Discussion Group. If you are a member of the North Hills Radio Club, your call is sufficient information. If not, you need to go into detail why you must join. When the following screen appears, you may log off and wait for an approval message in the next day or so.
